These are just a few of the key areas we emphasize to ensure that your child has a fulfilling and enriching educational experience at **American Montessori Public School**.

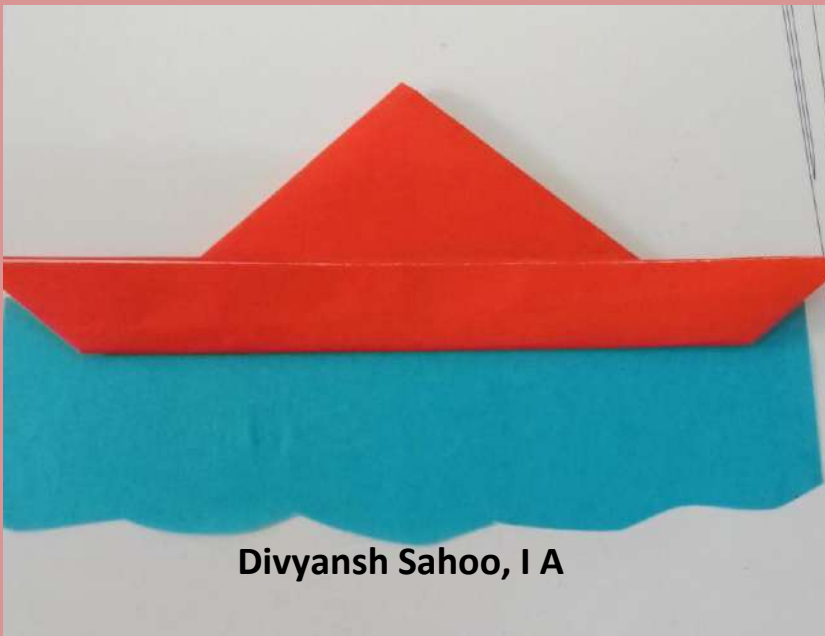
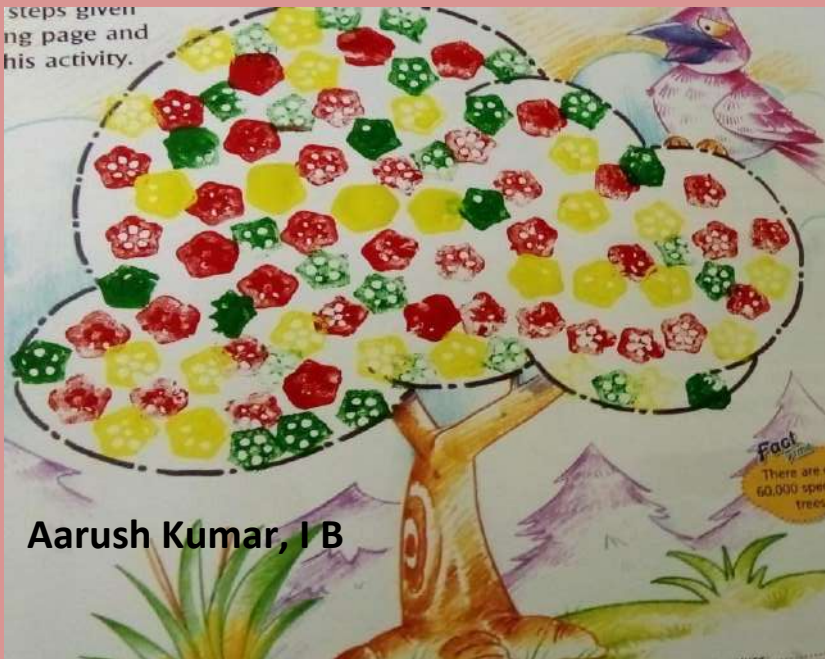
